

## A typical school day in Reception Class

## Start of the day 8:40 to 8:50





Please line up along the left allowing space for the children in Year 1 to 6 to walk through.

This is where the children will come into school. Children will be dropped off at the door.



## Start of the day

Children independently take off and hang their coats on their peg. They will put their water bottle in the tray.

## The children will write their name and then busy learn.

### **Monster Maths**

The children will take part in discrete math's lesson. This will be very practical and then they will apply their learning in the environment.





# Busy Learning indoors and outdoor

The children will access the learning environment to practise, apply and consolidate their knowledge and skills. The adults plan and set up the environment to support learning and development for all children.





### Read Write Inc

At John Shelton we follow the Read Write Inc program to teach sounds, reading and spelling.





## Snack and drinks

The children will be provided with a piece of fruit and milk at school. Each day your child will need to bring in a full bottle of fresh water which they can access throughout the day.



### Lunch Time 11:45 to 12:45

The children will have lunch with their class in the hall. We have experienced playleaders who will supervise them during lunch time.

The children use the Reception outdoor area during lunchtimes.



## School dinner or packed lunch?

All children in Reception are entitled to a free school meal. You will order your child's meal on-line. Children can also bring in a <u>healthy</u> packed lunch.

Please note no nuts allowed in school due to allergies. Grapes, cherry tomatoes need to be cut into small pieces. Drinks to be water or juice drinks.



### **Carpet Time**

The afternoon carpet session is where the children will learn through a topic or theme of interest.



## Story and Song Time

Everyday ends with a story and songs. These are vital for the children literacy development and a lot of fun!!! Reflect on the days learning.



### Home Time 3:10

Please wait outside the classroom in a line to allow others to pass safely. We will call the children and hand them over to you. Please let us know if it is someone else collecting your child as they will need a password.



If we need to speak to you we will call you to one side.

Please be patient with us while we learn who you are as we have lots of families and carers to meet.


# Parents/Carers as partners


### Attendance and Punctuality

### **Pupil Premium**

Important funding is allocated to school based on children eligible for free school meals and this helps our school. The school uses this money to benefit the children in lots of ways. Free school meals are different to the Universal school meals that Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children.
