Phonics Screening Check

Phonics Screening Check will take place during the week beginning of the 6th of June 2022.

What is the phonics screening check?

 A word-reading check at the end of Year 1 for ALL year one children and children in Year 2 who didn't meet the benchmark score.

- Shows how the children are progressing with their phonics skills for reading.
- Supports us to identify whether children need additional support with reading at this stage of reading.

What is in the Phonics Screening Check?

Children read 40 words

- ▶ 2 sections to the check, reading 'real' and 'nonsense' words
- ► The checks takes about 5-10 minutes
- Familiar member of staff will administer the screening
- Staff make it as 'low key' as possible children will not be informed its a "test"

Why do we teach phonics?

 Phonics helps children to develop good reading and spelling skills.
 e.g. cat can be sounded out for reading and spelling.

We use 'Read Write Inc' as our teaching resource to support the children with their reading, writing and spelling.




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

What is Phonics

Children begin to learn phonics (sounds) in Early Years both Nursery and Rieception. Once children begin learning sounds, these sounds are used orally to identify and make words. They will then begin to learn the letters which make each of the sounds and these are used to read and spell words. For this reason, the first initial sounds that are taught are 's', 'a', 'r', 'r', 'r', 'r'. These can immediately

For this reason, the first initial sounds that are taught are 's', 'a', 't', 'p', 'y', 'n'. These can immediately be blended for reading to make simple CVC words (consonant, vowel, consonant) e.g. sat, pin. Children then develop segmenting for writing skills, breaking the word into sounds to spell it out.

What is the Phonics Screening Check?

Children in Year 1 throughout the country will all be taking part in a phonics screening check during the same week in June. Children in Year 2 will also take the check if they did not achieve the required result when in Year 1 or they have not taken the test before.

Headteachers should decide whether it is appropriate for each of their pupils to take the phonics screening check. The phonics screening check is designed to confirm whether individual children have learnt phonic decoding and blending skills to an appropriate standard.

What Happens During the Screening?


The test contains 40 words. Each child will sit oneto-one and read each word aloud to a teacher. The test will take approximately 10 minutes per child, although at children are different and will complete the check at their own pace. The list of words the children read is a combination of 20 real words and 20 pseudo words (nonsense words).

Pseudo Words (Nonsense Words)

The pseudo words will be shown to your child with a picture of an ailen. This provides the children with a context for the pseudo word which is independent from any existing vocabulary with a year. As the pseudo words are included because they will be new to all pupils; they do not facult children with a good vocabulary knowledge or visual memory of words.

Reporting to Parents

By the end of the summer term all schools must report each child's results to their parents. They will also confirm if the child has met the standard threshold. Children who do not achieve the expected level will retake the test when they are in Year 2.








