As Readers and Writers...

In English, we will continue to learn and apply our phonics into reading and writing. We will continue to use capital letters, finger gaps and full stops in our writing and also use 'and' to join sentences and adjectives to add description.

In our focused Writing Weeks, we will be creating our own comic strip based on Traction Man. We will also be writing an information text about Giant Pandas.

As Scientists...

In Science, we will be learning about everyday materials. We will learn why we use different materials for different things. We will be looking at the difference between an object and what it is made of.

We will also be learning about plants. We will learn about different wild and common plants and label their basic features. We will have the opportunity to plant a seed and watch it grow and change.

As Artists...

In Art, we will be creating simple three dimensional shapes and structures using paper and card. We will also be learning fibre art skills such as plaiting, threading, knotting and weaving to create three-dimensional woven artworks inspired by artist Cecilia Vicuña.

Year 1 Summer Term

As Computer Programmers...

In Computing, we will be learning about giving instructions (algorithms) to complete activities. We will also learn about animated books and technology outside school on Purple Mash.

As Respectful Citizens...

In PSHE, we will be learning the correct names for our body parts and how we have changed since we were born. We will also be looking at jobs in the community during Money Week.

As Philosophers...

In RE, we will be learning about what Jewish children find important about religious days in Judaism.

As Musicians...

In Music, we will be using 'Carnival of the Animals' and 'Peter and the Wolf' for inspiration to compose our own music.

As Designers...

We will be exploring different types of windmills before we design and construct a windmill for a mouse to live in. We will also be learning about fruit and vegetables to make our own smoothies.

As Mathematicians...

In Maths, we will building on our place value knowledge to work with numbers up to 100. We will also be learning how to calculate the difference and solving one step problems.

We will be learning the difference between grouping and sharing in division by solving practical problems.

We will be building on our fractions knowledge to find quarters and learn how to tell the time to the nearest half an hour.

As Athletes...

In PE, we will be developing our attacking and defending skills in a variety of net, wall and invasion games. We will also be working on athletics as well as striking and fielding games.

As Historians...
