

As Readers and Writers...

In English, we will be using 'The Egyptian Cinderella' by Shirley Climo to provide a stimulus to rewrite a different version.

We will be using 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' by C. S. Lewis as the inspiration for writing a setting description of Narnia. We will also be writing an information text and a story set in an imaginary world.

As Scientists...

In Science, we will be learning about the functions of different parts of plants. We will explore what plants need for life and growth and explore the different ways that plants disperse their seeds.

We will also be learning about forces and magnets. We will explore simple pushes and pulls and see how the texture of an object or the surface it is on can affect how the object moves. We will also investigate magnets.

As Artists...

In Art, we will be exploring how shapes and negative spaces can be represented by three dimensional forms. We will learn ways to join and create free-standing structures inspired by the work of Anthony Caro.

We will also be developing design and craft skills taking inspiration from Ancient Egyptian art and pattern and paper making.

Year 3 Summer Term

As Computer Programmers...

In Computing, we will develop our email skills, including email safety, on Purple Mash. We will also be developing our presenting skills by using PowerPoint.

As Respectful Citizens...

In PSHE, we will be learning how to maintain physical and mental wellbeing. We will be looking at strategies for coping with change. We will also be looking at different people's jobs and skills and exploring job stereotypes.

As Philosophers...

In RE, we will be learning about how different religions show commitment through their day to day actions.

As Musicians...

In Music, we will be sing Roman songs and using war and battle music as inspiration for our own compositions.

As Designers...

In DT, we will be learning two new sewing techniques – cross-stitch and appliqué. Utilise these new skills to design and make a cushion or Egyptian collar. We will also be using seasonal foods to make a tart.

As Mathematicians...

In Maths, we will building on our fractions knowledge to add, subtract and find fractions of amounts. We will be calculating and solving problems involving money.

We will be learning to tell the time to the nearest minute and classifying angles, 2D and 3D shapes.

We will also be interpreting and drawing pictograms, tables and bar charts.

As Athletes...

In PE, we will be developing our swimming skills. We will also be working on our skills in athletics and cricket.

As Historians...

In History, we will be finding out about Egyptian beliefs using primary sources. We will investigate pyramids, gods and goddesses, and mummified people to identify Egyptian beliefs

As Geographers...

In Geography, we will be exploring different types of settlements. We will describe the different human and physical features in our local area and make land use comparisons with New Delhi.

In Languages, we will be learning the four seasons and the key features of each one.
