Four Seasons

Each year we experience these four seasons.



Spring

Spring is usually in the months **March, April and May**. In spring the days start to get longer and a bit warmer. New plants grow and the **trees grow their leaves back**. Many animals **have babies** such as birds, cows, sheep and ducks.



Summer

Summer is usually in the months **June, July and August**. In summer the **days are at their longest** and the **weather is the warmest**. The trees are **full of leaves**.

Autumn

Autumn is usually in the months **September, October and November**. In autumn the amount of time it is light becomes less which means it gets **darker earlier**. The leaves start to **change colour and fall off the trees**.



Winter

Winter is usually in the months **December, January and February**. In winter we have colder weather, **sometimes snow** and frost. The trees have no leaves and the amount of time it is light during the **day is at its shortest**.
