

As Readers and Writers...

In English, we will read 'Mo Farah' by Roy Apps. We will then write our own biographies about an athlete.

We will be using the story 'Holes' by Louis Sachar to provide a stimulus for writing a newspaper report.

We will use a video clip, 'The Lighthouse', to inspire us to write our own narrative. We will also write a free verse poem and perform it.

As Scientists...

In Science, we will be learning about the evolution and inheritance. We will learn about the work of Charles Darwin and how plants and animals can adapt over a long period of time to be better suited to their environment. Alongside this we will be learning about fossils and how they are formed.

As part of our sustainability units we will also be exploring renewable energy and the effects of light pollution.

As Artists...

In Art, we will be creating a memory box using a collection of found objects and hand-sculptured forms, reflecting primary school life with symbolic and personal meaning.

As Computer Programmers...

In Computing, we will develop our blogging skills on Purple Mash. We will also be learning how computers access the internet.

As Respectful Citizens...
