

As Readers and Writers...

In English, we will be using 'The Egyptian Cinderella' by Shirley Climo to as a stimulus to write our own alternative version of the story and to develop persuasive writing skills.

We will be using 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' by C. S. Lewis as inspiration for writing a detailed setting description of Narnia. We will also be writing and performing poetry.

As Scientists...

In Science, we will be learning about the functions of different parts of plants. We will explore what plants need for life and growth and explore the different ways that plants disperse their seeds.

We will also be learning about forces and magnets. We will explore simple pushes and pulls and see how the texture of an object or the surface it is on can affect how the object moves. We will also investigate magnets.

As Artists...

In Art, we will be exploring how shapes and negative spaces can be represented by three dimensional forms. We will learn ways to join and create free-standing structures inspired by the work of Anthony Caro.

We will also be developing design and craft skills taking inspiration from Ancient Egyptian art and pattern and paper making.

As Computer Programmers...

In Computing, we will develop our email skills, including email safety, on Purple Mash. We will also be developing our presenting skills by using PowerPoint.

As Respectful Citizens...

In PSHE, we will be learning how to maintain physical and mental wellbeing. We will be looking at strategies for coping with change. We will also be looking at different people's jobs and skills and exploring job stereotypes.

As Philosophers...

In RE, we will be exploring what religion and worldviews tell us about conflict, peace, forgiveness and reconciliation.

In Music, we will explore the work of 'Steven Price', who composed the music for 'Our Planet'. We will also learn to play the recorder.

As Designers...

In DT, we will be designing digital wearable technology and developing a program and housing for a Micro:bit. We will also be using seasonal foods to make a tart.

As Mathematicians...

In Maths, we will building on our fractions knowledge to add, subtract and find fractions of amounts. We will be calculating and solving problems involving money.

We will be learning to tell the time to the nearest minute and classifying angles, 2D and 3D shapes.

We will also be interpreting and drawing pictograms, tables and bar charts.

As Athletes...

In PE, we will be developing our OAA and tennis skills. We will also be working on our skills in athletics and cricket.

As Historians...

In History, we will be finding out about Egyptian beliefs using primary sources. We will investigate pyramids, gods and goddesses, and mummified people to identify Egyptian beliefs
